

## Public Art Committee Introduction

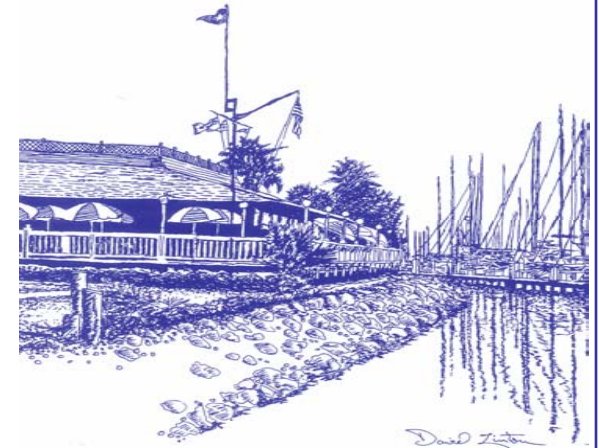

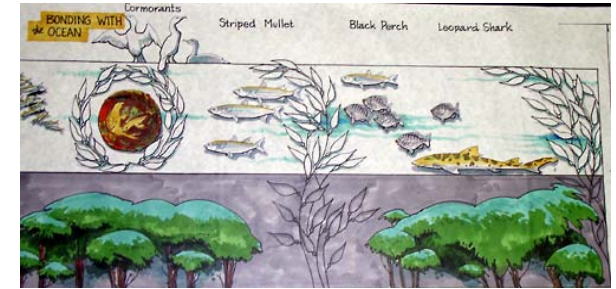
## PUBLIC ART COMMITTEE

### Kent Kraber

A forged stainless steel mural of 3' x 88', depicting sea life and 5 bronze medallions of items selected by the Club to highlight people, activities, or events from our history. Mural sits on and is integrated into a 3' stucco wall.



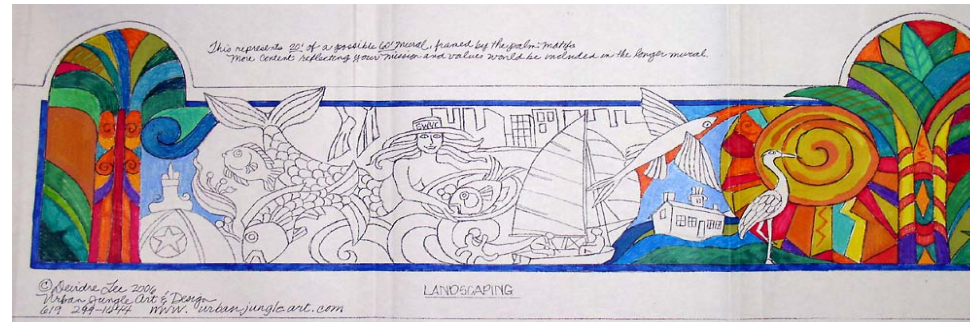
Partial of proposed mural section

### Deirde Lee

A tile mural, approximately 4' x 60', depicting designs from the sea and San Diego, framed by palms. Tiles are 12" x 12", with shaped tiles, finished in bold, bright glazes.

### Kohei Owatari

Glass mosaic tile create a mural with a whale, dolphins, the sun, moon and clouds. There is an element of sculpture in the dolphins and surf at the base of the mural. Plan includes desert type landscaping and boulders.



### Steven Rieman

This 90' metal mural screen, 5-6' high is fabricated from stainless steel and bronze with green patina. It features kinetic (moving) sail elements, and fishing boats extending above the horizon of the project.
